CONFLICT MINERALS SOURCING POLICY - SUMMARY

This summary outlines D-Wave's approach to responsible sourcing of Conflict Minerals (as defined below) in accordance with the United States ("U.S.") Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") regulations.

D-Wave is committed to responsible sourcing and compliance as described in Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Our *Conflict Minerals Sourcing Policy* (the "Policy") outlines the company's approach to identifying and reducing the use of tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold ("Conflict Minerals") that may directly or indirectly fund armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo ("DRC") and surrounding regions.

We take steps to ensure that Conflict Minerals used in our products are DRC conflict-free, and we expect transparency across our supply chain. Our program includes:

- Annual supplier assessments and product material reviews.
- Good faith reasonable country of origin inquiries.
- A commitment to working with suppliers who source from certified conflict-free smelters and refiners.
- Annual disclosure of conflict minerals usage through SEC Form SD.

Our policy applies to all D-Wave employees and contractors and reflects our broader commitment to ethical sourcing and compliance with U.S. regulations.
