

Missouri Awards State Contract for Student Information Systems to Tyler Technologies

More than 500 Missouri school districts can buy Tyler's student information solution at negotiated rate through new state contract

DALLAS – April 19, 2012 – The Missouri Office of Administration has awarded a contract for a student information system solution to Tyler Technologies, Inc. (NYSE: TYL).
