We are very invested in Maine's future, the future jobs available here, and in the people who can fill these jobs and increase the strength of the state and its competitive position in the global landscape.”

Project>Login understands that with a workforce shortage of trained computer and technology professionals in the region, many businesses have to look outside the area to fill open positions. By collaborating with Tyler and other sponsoring Maine-based businesses, Project>Login can raise the profiles of regional businesses and their job opportunities to college students throughout the state, with the intent of making both Maine businesses and their next generation of employees successful and competitive with the rest of the country and internationally.
