

The Buffalo and Fort Erie Public Bridge Authority Contracts with Tyler Technologies for Microsoft Dynamics AX

Bridge authority manages more than 6 million vehicle crossings annually between U.S. and Canada

The bridge opened to traffic in 1927 and spans the Niagara River between Fort Erie, Ontario, and Buffalo, New York; it is a key international border location. The Peace Bridge is the second-busiest border crossing between the two countries, with almost 6 million cars and trucks traveling across the bridge in 2013.
