

Dallas Central Appraisal District Signs Contract with Tyler Technologies

900-square-mile appraisal district will use Tyler Verify for street-level imaging and data verification services

PLANO, Texas – March 17, 2015 – Tyler Technologies, Inc. (NYSE: TYL) has signed a contract with the Dallas Central Appraisal District (DCAD) of Dallas County, Texas, for mass appraisal services using [Tyler Verify](#)™. The project, which is scheduled to be completed by November 2015, will include imaging and verification of DCAD's structures using a field-based stop, verify and compose approach to data collection.
