

Superior Court of California, County of San Mateo, Expands Agreement for Tyler Technologies' Odyssey Court Case Management System

This MSA was developed by a group of court managers and IT leaders within the California judicial system as a way for the state's superior courts to efficiently purchase a case management system. Odyssey has been selected for use by 25 of California's 58 superior courts.

San Mateo County has approximately 750,000 residents and is home to San Francisco International Airport.
