

New Hanover County, North Carolina, Signs Reappraisal Services Contract with Tyler Technologies

CLT Appraisal Services selected to appraise all residential, agricultural, commercial, exempt and industrial properties

The two-year project to reappraise the county’s more than 101,500 parcels is scheduled to be completed by March 2017. The county’s last reappraisal of real property was done in-house in 2012.

Tyler’s CLT Appraisal Services — the country’s only national mass appraisal services company — has appraised more than 30 million parcels across 46 states. The county also uses Tyler’s iasWorld® computer-assisted mass appraisal (CAMA) solution.

New Hanover County is the second-smallest county in the state by area but is one of the most populous counties with approximately 213,000 residents. Its county seat is Wilmington, home to the University of North Carolina Wilmington.
