

Calgary, Alberta, Signs \$5.9 Million Contract with Tyler Technologies for Appraisal Solution

Tyler's iasWorld software to streamline appraisal workflow for Alberta's largest city

The contract, valued at US\$5.9 million (CA\$7.6 million), includes software licenses, maintenance, support and implementation.

Calgary, which has approximately 510,000 properties and 1.2 million residents, selected Tyler's iasWorld® software, a proven solution that helps jurisdictions improve assessment quality, reduce operational and overhead costs, enhance data flow between agencies and improve employee productivity. iasWorld has been implemented in 25 U.S. states, Nova Scotia, Newfoundland and the Commonwealth of the Bahamas.

The City's assessment business unit (ABU) chose iasWorld to replace its legacy assessment solution due to Tyler's experience in Canada, its appraisal expertise, singular focus on serving the public sector, and Tyler's overall financial strength and stability.
