Paycom Software, Inc. Reports Third Quarter 2025 Results

Third Quarter Revenues of \$493 million, up 9% year-over-year

Third Quarter GAAP Net Income of \$111 million, representing 22% of total revenues, or \$1.96 per diluted share

Third Quarter Non-GAAP Net Income of \$110 million, or \$1.94 per diluted share

Third Quarter Adjusted EBITDA of \$194 million, representing 39% of total revenues

OKLAHOMA CITY--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- Paycom Software, Inc. ("Paycom," "we" and "our") (NYSE: PAYC), a leading provider of comprehensive, cloud-based human capital management software, today announced its financial results for the quarter ended September 30, 2025.

"We delivered another strong quarter of double-digit organic recurring revenue growth and expanding margins," said Paycom founder, CEO and chairman, Chad Richison. "Our award-winning products Beti, GONE and IWant continue to be differentiators in the market, expanding our sales pipeline. We remain focused on full-solution automation and command-driven navigation, which are delivering tremendous ROI for our clients and fundamentally transforming how executives, managers and employees engage with their HR and payroll information."

Financial Highlights for the Third Quarter of 2025

Total Revenues of \$493.3 million represented a 9.1% increase compared to total revenues of \$451.9 million in the same period last year. Recurring and other revenues of \$466.5 million increased 10.6% from the comparable

prior year period and constituted 94.6% of total revenues.

GAAP Net Income was \$110.7 million, or \$1.96 per diluted share, compared to GAAP net income of \$73.3 million, or \$1.31 per diluted share, in the same period last year. During the third quarter of 2025, GAAP net income included a tax-adjusted gain of \$26.3 million related to modification of our naming rights agreement.

Non-GAAP Net Income1 was \$109.6 million, or \$1.94 per diluted share, compared to \$93.4 million, or \$1.67 per diluted share, in the same period last year.

Adjusted EBITDA1 was \$194.3 million, compared to \$171.3 million in the same period last year.

Cash and Cash Equivalents were \$375.0 million as of September 30, 2025, compared to \$402.0 million as of December 31, 2024. During the quarter ended September 30, 2025, Paycom paid \$21.1 million in cash dividends and repurchased 1,023,790 shares of common stock for \$223.4 million, in the aggregate.

Total Debt was \$0 as of September 30, 2025 and December 31, 2024.

1 Adjusted EBITDA, non-GAAP net income and non-GAAP net income per diluted share are non-GAAP financial measures. Financial Outlook

Paycom provides the following expected financial guidance for the year ending December 31, 2025.

Total revenue in the range of \$2.045 billion to \$2.055 billion, representing year-over-year growth of approximately 9% at the midpoint.

Recurring and other revenue growth of approximately 10% year over year.

Interest on funds held for clients of approximately \$113 million.

Adjusted EBITDA in the range of \$872 million to \$882 million, representing a margin of approximately 43% at the midpoint.

We have not reconciled the forward-looking adjusted EBITDA ranges and adjusted EBITDA margin presented above and discussed on the teleconference call to net income, nor the forward-looking non-GAAP effective income tax

rate discussed on the teleconference call, to comparable GAAP measures because applicable information for future periods, on which these reconciliations would be based, is not readily available due to uncertainty regarding, and the potential variability of, depreciation and amortization, interest expense, taxes, non-cash stock-based compensation expense and other items. Accordingly, reconciliations of the forward-looking adjusted EBITDA ranges to net income, the forward-looking adjusted EBITDA margin to net income margin, and the forward-looking non-GAAP effective income tax rate to the GAAP effective income tax rate are not available at this time without unreasonable effort.

Use of Non-GAAP Financial Information

To supplement our financial information presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in the United States ("GAAP"), we present certain non-GAAP financial measures in this press release and on the related teleconference call, including adjusted EBITDA, non-GAAP net income, adjusted gross profit, adjusted gross margin, adjusted sales and marketing expenses, adjusted total administrative expenses, adjusted research and development expenses, adjusted total research and development costs, adjusted EBITDA margin, non-GAAP effective income tax rate, free cash flow and free cash flow margin. Management uses these non-GAAP financial measures as supplemental measures to review and assess the performance of our core business operations and for planning purposes. We define (i) adjusted EBITDA as net income plus interest expense, taxes, depreciation and amortization, non-cash stock-based compensation expense and certain transaction expenses that are not core to our operations (if any), less any gain on modification of the naming rights agreement, (ii) non-GAAP net income as net income plus non-cash stock-based compensation expense and certain transaction expenses that are not core to our operations (if any), less any gain on modification of the naming rights agreement, all of which are adjusted for the effect of income taxes, (iii) adjusted gross profit as gross profit plus applicable non-cash stock-based compensation expense, (iv) adjusted gross margin as gross profit plus applicable non-cash stock-based compensation expense, divided by total revenues, (v) each adjusted expense item as the GAAP expense amount less applicable non-cash stock-based compensation expense, (vi) adjusted total research and development costs as total research and development costs (including the capitalized portion) less applicable non-cash stock-based compensation (including the capitalized portion), (vii) adjusted EBITDA margin as adjusted EBITDA (calculated as described in clause (i)) divided by total revenues, (viii) non-GAAP effective income tax rate as the provision for income taxes plus the income tax effect on non-GAAP adjustments divided by non-GAAP net income (calculated as described in clause (ii)) plus the provision for income taxes and the income tax effect on non-GAAP adjustments, (ix) free cash flow as net cash provided by operating activities less purchases of intangible assets and purchases of property and equipment (which we also refer to as "capital expenditures" or "cap ex"), and (x) free cash flow margin as free cash flow (calculated as described in clause (ix)) divided by total revenues. The non-GAAP financial measures presented in this press release and discussed on the related teleconference call provide investors with greater transparency to the information used by management in its financial and operational decision-making. We believe

these metrics are useful to investors because they facilitate comparisons of our core business operations across periods on a consistent basis, as well as comparisons with the results of peer companies, many of which use similar non-GAAP financial measures to supplement results under GAAP. In addition, adjusted EBITDA is a measure that provides useful information to management about the amount of cash available for reinvestment in our business, paying dividends, repurchasing common stock and other purposes. Management believes that the non-GAAP measures presented in this press release and discussed on the related teleconference call, when viewed in combination with our results prepared in accordance with GAAP, provide a more complete understanding of the factors and trends affecting our business and performance.

The non-GAAP financial measures presented in this press release and discussed on the related teleconference call are not measures of financial performance under GAAP and should not be considered a substitute for net income, gross profit, gross margin, research and development expenses, sales and marketing expenses, administrative expenses, total research and development costs and GAAP effective income tax rate. Non-GAAP financial measures have limitations as analytical tools, and when assessing our operating performance, you should not consider these non-GAAP financial measures in isolation, or as a substitute for the consolidated statements of income data prepared in accordance with GAAP. The non-GAAP financial measures that we present may not be comparable to similarly titled measures of other companies, and other companies may not calculate such measures in the same manner as we do.

Financial Presentation

For the year ended December 31, 2024, we changed the presentation of revenues on the consolidated statements of comprehensive income to disaggregate interest on funds held for clients and combine recurring and other revenues. Prior period amounts have been reclassified to conform to this presentation. Reclassifications for the presentation of revenue did not have a material impact on previously reported amounts or change total revenues.

In the fourth quarter of 2024, we adopted the presentation of dollar amounts in millions, except amounts per share. As a result, amounts presented for prior periods may differ immaterially from those reported in previous filings and some amounts may not sum due to rounding. All percentages have been calculated using unrounded amounts.
