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MarketAxess Announces Monthly Volume Statistics for September 2014

NEW YORK, Oct. 2, 2014 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- MarketAxess Holdings Inc. (Nasdaq:MKTIX), the operator of a leading electronic trading platform for fixed-income securities, and the provider of market data and post-trade services for the global fixed-income markets, today announced total monthly trading volume for September 2014 of \$66.3 billion, consisting of \$41.0 billion in U.S. high-grade volume, \$19.7 billion in other credit volume, and \$5.6 billion in liquid products volume.

For the month of September 2014, estimated FINRA reported U.S. high-grade TRACE volume was \$333.7 billion, consisting of \$290.1 billion in registered securities and \$43.6 billion in 144A securities. MarketAxess believes that certain broker-dealers initiated reporting of affiliate back-to-back trades to FINRA in April 2014. The Company believes that this double counting of trades inflated the TRACE reported volume by approximately 3.5% for September 2014 and, accordingly, reduced the Company's estimated U.S. high-grade market share by approximately 0.5%. MarketAxess is providing both the reported and the adjusted estimated U.S. high-grade TRACE volumes on its website. The Company believes that adjusted estimated volumes provides a more accurate comparison to prior period reporting and, in the case of affiliate back-to-back trades, the adjusted volumes assumes a base level of such double-reported trades consistent with prior periods. FINRA has not yet made available any historical 144A data for periods prior to July 1, 2014.
