Tax Status of Distributions in 2020

The information on dividends paid by Crescent Capital BDC, Inc. (“Crescent BDC” or the “Company”) for 2020 is set forth below. For tax purposes, the Company is a regulated investment company (“RIC”) and designates the types of distributions you received as an investor in 2020 in accordance with Subchapter M of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (“IRC”).

Details of Distributions in 2020:

The amounts shown in the table below represent the final accounting of the Company’s 2020 distributions. These distributions were classified as follows:

Pursuant to IRC Section 881(e) and 871(k), the total percentage of ordinary dividends that is exempt from U.S. withholding is 98.02% as broken down as follows:

- Percentage of ordinary dividends that represent qualified interest income pursuant to IRC Section 871(k)(1) = 98.02%
- Percentage of ordinary dividends that represent short term capital gain pursuant to IRC Section 871(k)(2) = 0.00%

Distributions that were reinvested through the Company’s Dividend Reinvestment Plan are treated, for tax purposes, as if they had been paid in cash. Therefore, stockholders who participated in the Dividend Reinvestment Plan should also refer to the table above for appropriate tax treatment of 2020 dividends.
